Time Frame (Daniel 10:1-2)

¹ In <u>the third year of Cyrus king of Persia</u> a message was revealed to Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar. The message was true, but the appointed time was long; and he understood the message, and had understanding of the vision. ² In those days I, Daniel, was mourning three full weeks. ³ I ate no pleasant food, no meat or wine came into my mouth, nor did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.

536/5 BCThree years after the fall of Babylon

The Vision Understood (Daniel 10:1-2)

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70 Weeks (Daniel 9:20-27)
2300 Days (c.f. Daniel 12:8-9)



Daniel's Distress (Daniel 10:1-2)

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 - Concern for those who left for Jerusalem (Ezra 4:4-5)
 Concern for those who stayed in Babylon (Esther 3:8)
 Concern for the future of his people (Daniel 10:14)

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 - For what purpose did this aged servant of God thus humble himself and afflict his soul? – Evidently to understand more fully the divine purpose concerning the events that would befall the church of God.



Daniel's Day Vision: Time Frame (Daniel 10:4-6)

- ⁴ ¶ Now on the twenty-fourth day of the first month, as I was by the side of the great river, that *is*, the Tigris, ⁵ I lifted my eyes and looked, and behold, a certain man clothed in linen, whose waist *was* girded with gold of Uphaz! ⁶ His body *was* like beryl, his face like the appearance of lightning, his eyes like torches of fire, his arms and feet like burnished bronze in color, and the sound of his words like the voice of a multitude.
 - Shortly after the Passover
 - Commemoration of the liberation of God's people and a reminder of God's promised rest.

- and in the midst of the seven lampstands One like the Son of Man, clothed with a garment down to the feet and girded about the chest with a golden band. ¹⁴ His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes like a flame of fire; ¹⁵ His feet were like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, and His voice as the sound of many waters; ¹⁶ He had in His right hand seven stars, out of His mouth went a sharp twoedged sword, and His countenance was like the sun shining in its strength. ¹⁷ And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead. But He laid His right hand on me, saying to me, "Do not be afraid; I am the First and the Last. ¹⁸ I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of Hades and of Death.

¹⁰ Suddenly, a hand touched me, which made me tremble on my knees and on the palms of my hands. ¹¹ And he said to me, "O Daniel, man greatly beloved, understand the words that I speak to you, and stand upright, for I have now been sent to you." While he was speaking this word to me, I stood trembling. ¹² Then he said to me, "Do not fear, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand, and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard; and I have come because of your words.

A Character Shift (Daniel 10:10-12)

¹⁰ And, behold, an hand touched me, which set me upon my knees and upon the palms of my hands.
 ¹¹ And he said unto me, O Daniel, a man greatly beloved, understand the words that I speak unto thee, and stand upright: for unto thee am I now sent. And when he had spoken this word unto me, I stood trembling.
 ¹² Then said he unto me, Fear not, Daniel: for from the first day that thou didst set thine heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God, thy words were heard, and I am come for thy words.

Michael and The Prince of Persia (Daniel 10:13)

 ¹³ But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days; and behold, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I had been left alone there with the kings of Persia.

• The Devil (c.f. John 12:31)

¹² For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*. (Ephesians 6:12)

Michael and The Prince of Persia (Daniel 10:13)

 ¹³ But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days; and behold, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I had been left alone there with the kings of Persia.

Michael is Jesus Christ

- The name Michael means "Who is Like God" (Jn. 10:30)
- Jewish literature identifies Michael as the highest of angels, often reflecting it in the scriptures by the title the Angel of Yahweh
- The Angel of Yahweh is portrayed as having the ability to forgive sins (Exodus 23:21, c.f. Mark 2:7)
- Angel does not signify a created being but describes a function as messenger.
- In Daniel 10:21, Michael is called "your prince", meaning the prince of you (Daniel) of God's people. Isaiah calls the Jesus the Messiah the "Prince of Peace" (Isaiah 9:6) and Daniel refers to the Jesus the Messiah as "Messiah the prince" (Daniel 9:25).

Troubled in the Presence of Holiness (Daniel 10:14-17)


