





4 Corners

Matthew 24:31

 And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

4 Winds

Jeremiah 39:46

 Against Elam I will bring the four winds from the four quarters of heaven, and scatter them toward all those winds; there shall be no nations where the outcasts of Elam will not go.

Daniel 7:2-3

 Daniel spoke, saying, "I saw in my vision by night, and behold, the four winds of heaven were stirring up the Great Sea. ³ And four great beasts came up from the sea, each different from the other.

- 4 Angels
 - A contrast to the four horseman (Rev 6:1-8)
- 4 Corners
 - "the four points of the compass"
 - Describe the global significance of the event
- 4 Wind
 - Destructive forces by which God executes judgement on the wicked.
 - May represent the earthly catastrophes that occur under the trumpets (Rev 8:2-21;11:15-18) and bowls (Rev 16:1-21).

 - Scriptural Examination
 - Ezekiel 43:2

 - ²⁷ For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. ²⁸ For wherever the carcass is, there the eagles will be gathered together. - What is the Seal?
 - A Scriptural Case for the Name of God?
 - Both a case could be made for the Sabbath and the Spirit. Those who bear the seal must be Commandment Keepers. This involves both Sabbath and Spirit. In order to be sealed, the Sabbath, a commandment, must be kept along with the others. The Spirit is God's "first installment and our assurance of salvation. God knows we abide in Him (1 John 3:24) and it is this same Spirit that helps us to do God's will (i.e. keep His commandments, see Romans 8:9).

 - A Scriptural Case for the Name of God?
 - Nevertheless, according to the context of Revelation, the seal of God, written in the foreheads of the faithful, as revealed in Revelation 14:1 is the NAME OF GOD.
 - To bear this name, you MUST be a COMMANDMENT KEEPER. In order to do this, you MUST HAVE THE HOLY SPIRIT.

Revelation 7:4

- The Tribes.
 - Not literal Israel but Spiritual Israel Romans 14:6
 - Therefore it is of faith that it might be according to grace, so that the promise might be sure to all the seed, not only to those who are of the law, but also to those who are of the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all

Galatians 3:7

Therefore, recognize that it is those who are of faith who are sons of Abraham.



• Rev. 7:4 And I heard the number of those who were sealed. One hundred and forty-four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel were sealed:

- "I Saw I Heard Pattern"
- Chapter 1:
 - John first hears "a loud voice as of a trumpet" behind him (1:10); when he turns around, he instead sees Jesus walking [amid] the seven lampstands (1:12-13).
- Chapter 5:
 - John first hears that the Lion from the tribe of Judah has overcome; when he turns to see the Lion, he sees the Lamb as having been slain (5:5–6). Both are the images of Christ: the Lion shows what Christ did and the Lamb how he did it.



 Rev. 7:4 And I heard the number of those who were sealed. One hundred and forty-four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel were sealed:

- "I Saw I Heard Pattern"
- Chapter 17:
 - John hears of "the great prostitute sitting on many waters" (17:1); what he later sees is "a woman sitting on a scarlet beast" whose name is Babylon (17:3). This shows that the beast and the waters refer to the same political, secular entity specified in 17:15.
- Chapter 21:
 - John first hears of "the bride, the wife of the Lamb" (21:9), but he actually sees "the holy city Jerusalem" in its glory (21:10-11)

Revelation 7:4

- "I Saw I Heard Pattern"
- Chapter 7:
 - John first hears the number 144,000 as being God's embattled, sealed people (7:4); when he sees the same group, they appear to him as a great multitude that nobody could count (7:9). The groups are thus the same saints in different roles and circumstances.

REYELATION

• Rev. 7:4 And I heard the number of those who were sealed. One hundred and forty-four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel were sealed:

Revelation 7:4

- Literal or Figurative
 - Based on the text, the 144,000 appears symbolic.
 - A transition from a militant church broken up into divisions on earth, to a triumphant church multitudinous in heaven.
 - Is this the right question?
 - Who shall be able to stand?

Interlude: The Great and Diverse Multitude

- Rev. 7:9 After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands,
- Rev. 7:10 and crying out with a loud voice, saying,
 "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!"
- Rev. 7:11 All the angels stood around the throne and the elders and the four living creatures, and fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God,
- Rev. 7:12 saying: "Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom,

A Gospel for All

- The gospels impact is far reaching.
- The gospels is not to be kept from others because of our own prejudice.
- A Gospel with Results
 - The question has been answered.
 - Who shall be able to stand?
 - Not a few, but a great innumerable multitude.

Revelation 8:1

What is this Silence?

- There are many opinions, but nothing can be deemed as concrete.
 - 1. Some think that the silence relates to the offering of the prayers of the saints (8:3–4).
 - 2. Others hold that this silence corresponds to the silence at the beginning of the creation—that is to say, in Genesis 1:2 all was dark and silent.
 - 3. The silence is also considered to be the astonished universe in the expectation of the judgments of God about to be launched on the wicked (cf. Hab. 2:20).


